## 申请须知 Information for applicants



#### 背景

自 2003 年起,旅游奖学金已为中国内地和香港特区植物园之间提供紧密的工作关系和联系,我们认为,此学习交流能让职员分享经验及带来更多合作机会,从而加强两地植物园对植物保护的工作。

在 2013 年,嘉道理农场暨植物园(KFBG)将 联同国际植物园保护联盟(BGCI)提供**六个**奖 学金名额,给中国内地植物园和植物保护机构 的职员来港作短期的交流。

#### **Background**

Since 2003, the travel scholarships are intended to support closer working relations and linkages between mainland China and Hong Kong SAR botanic gardens. It is envisaged that the placement of staff will promote the sharing of knowledge and lead to collaborative projects to further improve botanic gardens efforts to conserve plants in mainland China and the Hong Kong SAR.

In 2013, KFBG together with BGCI will offer 6 scholarships to staff from botanic gardens and plant conservation organisations in mainland China for a short-term study tour at KFBG in the Hong Kong SAR.

#### Who should apply?

Young conservation scientists, researchers and non-research staff from botanic gardens and plant conservation organisations in mainland China who are in the early stages of their careers.

Persons holding senior positions in their organisation will <u>NOT</u> be considered for this programme.

#### 奖学金内容

- 提供一个机会给来自中国内地植物园和植物保护机构的职员,在 2013 年 1 月 21 日至 2 月 2 日为期约 2 个星期的期间,到香港与嘉道理农场暨植物园的职员一起学习与交流;
- 参加者将与主办植物园建立联系,并将所学习 到的项目在其植物园落实进行;
- 资助来往主办植物园的双程旅费(铁路或航空);
- 资助项目期间的住宿费;
- 资助项目期间的膳食及交通费津贴,每天为港币\$200:
- 成功完成项目者可获发出席证书。

#### **Programme details**

- An opportunity for staff in mainland China botanic gardens and plant conversation organisations to join the training and an exchange visit to Hong Kong with KFBG for about 2 weeks from 21<sup>st</sup> January to 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2013.
- Participants to form networks with host botanic garden and implement elements of the programme in their "home garden".
- Sponsor return tickets (for train or flight) to host botanic garden.
- Provide accommodation during the training period.
- Provide food and local travel stipend during the training period in Hong Kong (HK\$200 per day).
- An attendance certificate on successful completion of the programme.

#### Requirement

- Good written and spoken Chinese and/or English.
- Field of work should be related to the theme 'Conservation Genetics'.
- Have to fully participate and complete the programme.
- Attend to all the scheduled session arranged by the host botanic garden.
- Do a presentation and share your experience of the programme with your colleagues within 2 months upon return to your own botanic garden.
- Submit a written report to BGCI and KFBG within 2 months after completion of the programme.

Your performance during the programme will be assessed and reported to your supervisor or the director of your botanic garden.
