



## Post Conference Tour to Oxford\*

Thursday, 11th July 2013

This one day tour will take you to Oxford – often called the ‘city of spires’.

The trip takes between 75 and 90 minutes and you will be able to enjoy views of pleasant English countryside.

On arrival at Oxford we will be visiting the hidden gem that is Oxford’s Botanic Garden , in the city centre tucked alongside the river, where staff will offer a tour of the garden and a talk about their education programme.

Following lunch you will be free to visit any of the other exciting sights Oxford has to offer- take a trip on a punt along the river, walk through one of the stunning colleges (a fee is usually charged) or visit the extraordinary Ashmolean Museum and Library.

The cost of the day trip is **£35** per person which includes the return coach journey, entrance to the botanic gardens, morning tea or coffee and your lunch. You will need additional money to cover the cost of any afternoon museum/ college visits or for river trips.
