

Getting to Kew Gardens

Coming by public transport?

To find out the best route to Kew by public transport, use the <u>Transport for London Journey Planner</u>

London Underground

Kew Gardens Station (District Line - Richmond branch), is the closest London Underground station, and is in zone 3. Kew Gardens Station is 0.4km from the Victoria Gate entrance to the Gardens. Exit the station past the parade of shops, cross Sandycombe Road at the zebra crossing and walk down Lichfield Road (opposite) to reach Victoria Gate.

Please always check the <u>Transport for London</u> website for service disruptions before making your journey.

Overland train

Train services (South West Trains) from Waterloo, via Vauxhall and Clapham Junction, stop at **Kew Bridge** station. Kew Bridge station is 0.5km from the Queen Elizabeth Gate entrance to the Gardens. For more information call +44 (0)8457 484950 or visit the National Rail Journey Planner.

Please note, the London Overground service from Stratford stops at **Kew Gardens** Station.

Bus

Route 65 stops close to Victoria Gate and Jodrell Gate. Route 391 stops close to Jodrell Gate and Kew Gardens Station. Routes 237 and 267 stop at Kew Bridge station.
