

Botanical Garden of Institute of Medicinal Plant Development

Botanical garden of IMPLAD is one of the major medicinal plant gardens in Asia. Its main aim is to widely collect the breeds of medicinal plants, protect medicinal plants resources and popularize the traditional Chinese



medicine. The garden has a great collection of more than 1500 species of medicinal plants, covering an area of 20 hectares. It's alive with opportunities for discovery, from the modern 3000m² conservatory which house over 1000 species of specimens



and crude drugs.

The botanical garden attracts amounts of scholars and trip regiments every year. The garden also undertake the

teaching and practice assignments from Peking university, Tsinghua university and China Agriculture university, often help primary and middle school to hold biology science summer camp.
