

how to make a biodiversity mobile

1. Colour and cut out the pictures of plants, animals, "me", and the title on the next page.
2. Glue the pictures onto coloured construction paper and cut around the outline of the pictures again. (Optional: select, cut out, and glue pictures of animals, plants, or people from magazines and glue them on the other side of the construction paper.)
3. Using a hole punch, make a hole at the top of each picture cut out.
4. Punch 8 holes spread evenly around the edge of the paper plate or cardboard circle.
5. Cut lengths of string. Each string can be a different length of between 15 centimetres and 1 metre long.
6. Tie a knot around the hole in each picture. Tie the other end of each string into one of the holes in the paper plate or cardboard circle.
7. Using a sharp pencil, punch a hole in the middle of the paper plate or cardboard circle. Using a sharp pencil, push a length of string through the hole. Tie a knot in the string on the same side as the pictures are hanging from. Now you can hang it up!
