

The National Herbarium & Botanic Garden (NHBG) at Zomba

Zomba was the first botanic garden established in Malawi. It was founded by Alexander Whyte, Scottish explorer and botanist, between 1891 and 1895 and was originally the grounds of the British Consul's Residency (now the Government Hostel). The garden was established as an experimental area for newly introduced plants in order to promote agricultural enterprise. After independence the maintenance of the garden was entrusted to the Forestry Department until it was transferred to the National Herbarium and Botanic Garden (NHBG) in 1987.

The NHBG has since established two more gardens in Lilongwe and Mzuzu, and all three botanic gardens are involved in *in situ* and *ex situ* conservation of rare and endangered plant species, e.g. *Widdringtonia whytei* (Mulanje Cedar) and *Khaya anthotheca* (Mbawa). They also offer recreational and educational services, and propagate and sell a number of ornamental and indigenous plants.
