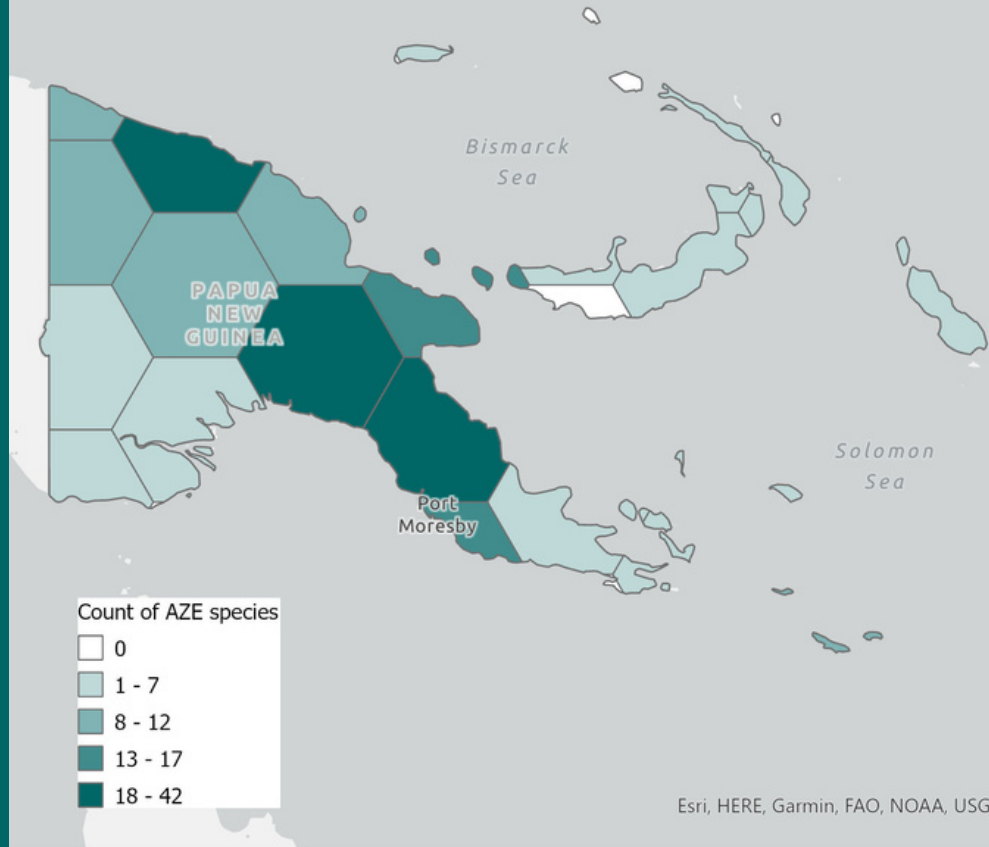




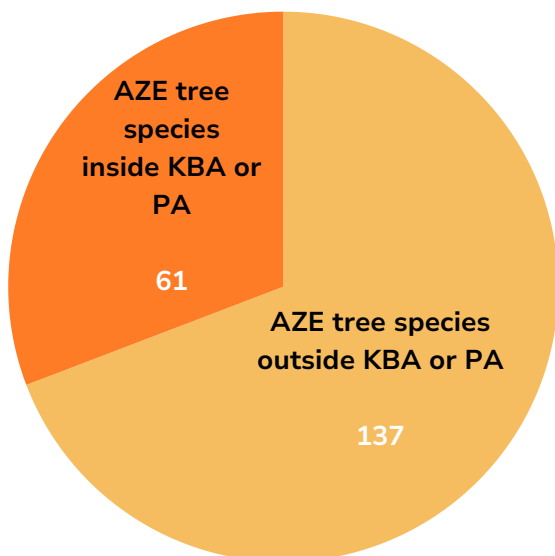

AZE Tree Species: PNG

The three principles of Alliance for Zero Extinction (AZE) sites are Endangerment, Irreplaceability & Discreetness.



- 198 Papua New Guinea tree species trigger Alliance for Zero Extinction (AZE) sites
- Representing 6.8% globally identified AZE tree species
- 45% Critically Endangered and Endangered PNG trees are AZE tree species



- 69% PNG AZE tree species only occur outside Key Biodiversity Areas (KBA) or Protected Areas (PA)
- 31% PNG AZE tree species occur inside a KBA or PA
- 35 PNG AZE tree species occur completely within existing KBA
