Grant	Amount (USD)	Region	Purpose/Criteria	Month Open
Member	\$2,500	Global	For projects that improve or support one or more of the vital areas across the botanic garden as defined by BGCI's Botanic Garden Accreditation (see here). E.g. Conservation, education, facilities, training.	May
ArbNet Partnership Programme	\$5,000	Global	For projects that focus on tree conservation and involve a partnership between two botanical institutions. At least one of the two partners must be an ArbNet accredited arboretum and both institutions must be BGCI Members.	May
Minnesota Landscape Arboretum	\$750-\$1,500	Global	For small projects to help botanic gardens or arboreta that are having difficulty in carrying out their mission. The grants may be used for any part of the gardens' work, including operations, conservation, education or research.	May
Leon Levy Native Plant Preserve	\$4,500	Caribbean & Central America (as defined by the CCABG Network)	For projects that improve or support one or more of the vital areas across the botanic garden as defined by BGCI's Botanic Garden Accreditation (see here), and carry out the implementation of the Plant Conservation Strategy for the Caribbean Region. Read the strategy here: English Español	May
Global Seed Conservation	\$4,000	Global	For botanical institutions to create new seed collections of threatened species, increase seed banking capacity and duplicate <u>at least two species</u> in the Baekdudaegan Global Seed Vault, Korea. Only species with known and confirmed orthodox storage properties can be included and at least one new accession must be incorporated into your institution's seed bank.	May
International Day of Education	\$1,000-\$2,000	Global	For projects aligned with BGCI's Declaration of Intent on Climate Action Education . These grants focus on climate education activities and are open in January each year.	January
